



Contact Lens Policy

Included in your contact lens evaluation is **120 days** of follow-up lens related care. We will make your follow up appointments according to the doctor's recommendations, but it is the patient's responsibility to comply with those recommendations. Any needed care beyond 120 days will be subject to an office visit fee. Professional fees are non-refundable.

Contact lenses are medical devices with the prescription valid for **one year**. In order for Larson Eye Center to comply with federal law, no contacts will be dispensed beyond the expiration date. Likewise, only the appropriate number of disposable lens boxes will be dispensed that fulfills the one year prescription. Annual contact lens examinations are required to renew prescriptions.

Trial Lenses: Due to limited trial lens availability from contact lens manufacturers, trial contact lenses will be dispensed only to patients who order their contact lenses through Larson Eye Center.

Exchanges can be made with lenses that are purchased at Larson Eye Center. Rigid gas permeable contact lenses can be exchanged within 90 days of the initial date of the contact lens exam. **Disposable lenses can be exchanged up to one year.** This is for the rare case of a prescription change within a year. The boxes need to have the factory seal intact and no markings on them. We are unable to take back any opened boxes, expired boxes or boxes that have writing on them.

As a courtesy, an annual supply of contact lenses will be shipped to your home or office at no additional charge.
