

## **OFFICE REFRACTION POLICY**

A “refraction” is the process of determining the optimal eyeglass prescription for your eyes. This is not only to allow us to prescribe eyeglasses, but more importantly to determine your best corrected vision. The refraction helps us to distinguish whether vision problems are caused by glasses or from eye disease.

A refraction may or may not be performed at the time of your visit, depending upon your doctors judgment of its necessity. This service is not covered by Medicare and by private insurance. If a refraction is performed, there will be a fee of \$30.00.

It is our policy to collect the refraction fee at the time of service. We will not submit this charge to your insurance. If you feel your insurance may pay for the refraction, we will give you the appropriate paperwork to assist you in submitting your claim.
